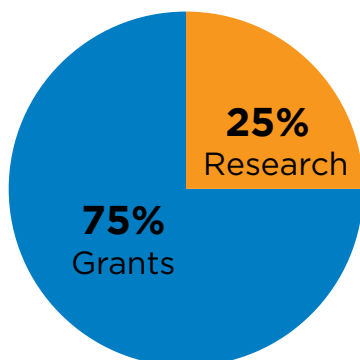


SUSAN G. KOMEN NORTHWEST OHIO COMMUNITY IMPACT

Thanks to community support over the past 23 years Komen Northwest Ohio has funded \$11 million in local grants for life-saving breast health and breast cancer education, screening, treatment and survivorship services in the 24-county service area. In addition, nearly \$3 million has been contributed to national research initiatives to find the cures. WHERE DO THE DOLLARS GO?

Of the money we raise, 75% stays in Northwest Ohio to fund education, outreach, and life-saving grants and the remaining 25% goes to fund the best breast cancer research aimed at finding the cures.

Know Your Normal

See a health care provider if you notice any changes to your breasts including:

- Lump, hard knot or thickening inside the breast or underarm area
- Swelling, warmth, redness or darkening of the breast
- Change in the size or shape of the breast
- Dimpling or puckering of the skin
- Itchy, scaly sore or rash on the nipple
- Pulling in of your nipple or other parts of the breast
- Nipple discharge that starts suddenly
- Lingering new pain in one spot
